John Anderson according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South West quarter of the North East quarter and the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Twenty one, in Township One Hundred North, of Range Seven West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Dubuque, Iowa, containing Eighty acres

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been purchased by the said John Anderson

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said John Anderson

and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

John Anderson and to his heirs and assigns forever.
